Facilitator Requests (Space Agreements)

1. Don't make assumptions-race, sexual orientation ect.
2. Take responsibility for your own learning
3. Be where you need to be —take space if you need to in order to show up for the group later — go the bathroom if you need to
4. Take space- make space—Ask, who's voice should be heard now?
 - more talkative people: allow space for other voices to be heard
 - quieter people: your contributions are very welcome
 - examine your own privilege and how that informs your contributions
5. Use I statements
6. Oppression exists (we are not here to argue)
7. If you choose to speak as a member of the SfSS, try your best to reflect our vision and mission statement
8. It's all love, we are all here for a common goal, meet each other where we are
9. All agreements are open to reflection, change, and growth
